RSP 1.1	Withdraw the proposed change to the definition of soil.	Higgins Aggregates Ltd (1)
RSP 1.2	Retain the proposed change to the definition of soil.	Department of Conservation (4)
RSP 1.3	Retain the definition of Soil as in the operative Regional Soil Plan, or amend the definition to take account of Winstone's concerns that the additional wording in the proposed changes is confusing. The amended interpretation could be such that alluvium and rock fragments abstracted (either from the ground or from the river) as part of existing legally established quarry operations may require earthworks consents for soil disturbance under the Soil Plan. RSP 1.4	Leave the definition of soil as is.	Horokiwi Quarries (12)
