# WAIOHINE RIVER MANAGEMENT SCHEME RATING CLASSIFICATION

## **CLASS DEFINITIONS**

### CLASS A

Weighting of 6 (Red)

This area receives a *high* degree of flood relief. Flooding was a regular occurrence prior to the current flood protection measures providing a high level of flood protection.

#### **CLASS B**

Weighting of 5 (Orange)

Receives a *moderate* degree of flood relief. Flooding occurred occasionally prior to the current flood protection measures providing a high level of flood protection <u>or</u> flooding occurred regularly prior to the current moderate level of flood protection.

#### **CLASS C**

Weighting of 4 (Blue)

Receives a *moderate to low* degree of flood relie<u>for</u> receives protection from river course change. Flooding occurred rarely prior to the current flood protection measures providing a high level of flood protection <u>or</u> flooding occurred occasionally prior to the current moderate level of flood protection<u>or</u> the current river channel management measures reduce the risk of course change.

## **CLASS D**

Weighting of 3 (Green)

Receives a *low* degree of flood relief. Flooding occurred occasionally prior to the current flood protection measures providing a low level of flood protection.

#### CLASS E

Weighting of 2 (Yellow)

Receives a *very low* degree of flood relief. Flooding occurred rarely prior to the current flood protection measures providing a low level of flood protection.

## **CLASS S**

Weighting of 100

Dwellings and their immediate surroundings, which without the current flood protection measures, would be at an increased risk of being surrounded or entered by floodwaters.

## **CLASS X**

Non-rateable

Unaffected land outside of above classes.
