Mr Southey raised his concern regarding the rights of coastal landholders to have Federated Farmers representation at the coastal development strategy meetings. Cr Buchanan indicated that it had been agreed at the Coastal Forum that the first stage would involve representatives from local government working together to set up a process in order to develop a standard approach for the management of the Wairarapa coastline. It was proposed that involvement of major stakeholders/landowners and the community would occur at a later stage.

Mr Dalziell advised the Committee that the Animal Health Board proposed to notify the Proposed National Strategy at the end of April with the Board endeavouring to ensure that the expanded Bovine Tb vector control programme commenced on 1 July 2001.

Members noted that consideration of the Bovine Tb vector control budget situation was dependent on timeframes and agreed that this aspect would be raised at the May Committee meeting in order to establish whether a special meeting was required.

Cr Turver queried the monitoring of the sawfly in the western part of the region. The Manager, Operations said he would ensure that the monitoring information would be exchanged between the Landcare and Wairarapa Divisions.

Concerning 3.12 – Technical Services Section Projects

The Section Leader, Technical Services gave a presentation on the capabilities of the Arcview flood photos database recently completed as part of stage one of the project.

Concerning 5.1 (7) Bovine Tb Trend Monitors

Mr Dalziell advised that as part of negotiations with the Crown for future funding requirements the Animal Health Board was moving towards ensuring total contestability of all Bovine Tb vector control operations.
