Divisional Report

1. **Purpose**

- To comment on the Utility Services Division's financial performance for the nine months ended 31 May 2001.
- To outline various other relevant areas of interest or activity.

2. Divisional Performance for 11 Months Ended 31 May 2001

Water Supply

The overall financial position continues to improve and after eleven months shows a better than budget performance of \$1.2 million. It should be noted that this excludes the accounting generated surplus from Hutt City Council's contribution to defluoridating Petone's water. It is pleasing also to record that operating expenditure, as well as financial costs, are tracking under last year for the eleven months to date.

The capital expenditure forecast shows that pretty well all projects will be completed within time. Savings on completed projects included in our original 2000/01 budget are expected to be \$462,000. In addition, projects worth \$298,000 have been deferred for various reasons.

Plantation Forestry

Unfortunately our results for April and May have been disappointing because of the weaker market. We continue to forecast a year-end deficit of \$246,000.
