The New Zealand Historic Places Trust is writing to inform you of the proposal to register the Rimutaka Incline as an historic area in the New Zealand Historic Places Trust register of historic places, historic areas, wahi tapu and wahi tapu areas.

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- e) the territorial authority having jurisdiction in the area; and
- e) the appropriate iwi.

There is provision in sections 29 and 30 for the confirmation of the registration by agreement with the owner of the place and every person having a registered interest in the place.
