1. **Purpose**

2. **Background**

Section 182 (1) of the Land Transport Act 1998 States:

"Every regional council that is required to prepare a regional land transport strategy must prepare an annual report on the progress in implementing its regional land transport strategy."

The report (**Attachment 1**) fulfils that requirement by commenting on:

- Context within legislation
- Impediments to implementing the strategy
- Performance measures
- Progress against objectives; and
- Progress with corridor studies
