## State Highway 1 Corridor Strategy: Tawa to MacKays Crossing

## 1. Purpose

To advise the Committee on Transit New Zealand activities on the State Highway 1 Corridor – Tawa to MacKays Crossing.

# 2. Background

In July 2000 the Western Corridor Plan was adopted as part of the Regional Land Transport Strategy. The Western Corridor Plan envisaged:

- a second Paremata bridge
- safety improvements
- an upgrade to MacKays Crossing
- a medium level of passenger rail improvements including Waikanae electrification and improved levels of service
- to pursue Transmission Gully at the earliest time that legislation and funding would allow.

This plan specifically prevented projects such as the Pukerua Bay Bypass or other capacity improvements north of Pukerua Bay on the existing State Highway 1 to MacKays Crossing.

### 3. Comment
