PARTICULAR AREAS FOR OFFICERS TO REVIEW

Councillors have indicated that the following major issues should be given further consideration:

- The total environmental monitoring programme, placing a greater emphasis on ground water monitoring rather than air quality monitoring.
- The timing and measures included in the programme for implementing Floodplain Management plans.
- Opportunities for generating income eg the Parks and Forests.

In addition Councillors have indicated that the following specific items should be looked at:

- Flood recovery fund
- Implementation of the Wairarapa wetlands regional park
- Sustainable farming as part of Parks programme
- Marine and estuarine education issues
- The principle of green energy
- Biodiversity proposal for the Wainuiomata dam
- Super KNE within the Wainuiomata catchment
- Continued funding of Rimutaka toilets
