## **Request for information 2023-062**

I refer to your request for information dated 23 March 2023 which was received by Greater Wellington Regional Council (Greater Wellington) on 23 March 2023. You have requested the following:

We are in the process of collating these documents for release. These will be sent to you separately by 1 May 2023.

If you have any concerns with the decision(s) referred to in this letter, you have the right to request an investigation and review by the Ombudsman under section 27(3) of the Local Government Official Information and Meetings Act 1987.

Please note that it is our policy to proactively release our responses to official information requests where possible. Our response to your request will be published shortly on Greater Wellington's website with your personal information removed.
